# What Have We Achieved?



- Federal studies show that 4+ years of art education leads to an average 50 point improvement in SAT scores
- After four years of participation our star student is currently at Purdue studying Graphic Design
- 98% of students report that they improved their art skills
- Students with extended participation (up to a year) demonstrate improved literacy
- Teachers report better behavior from AWAH educated children
